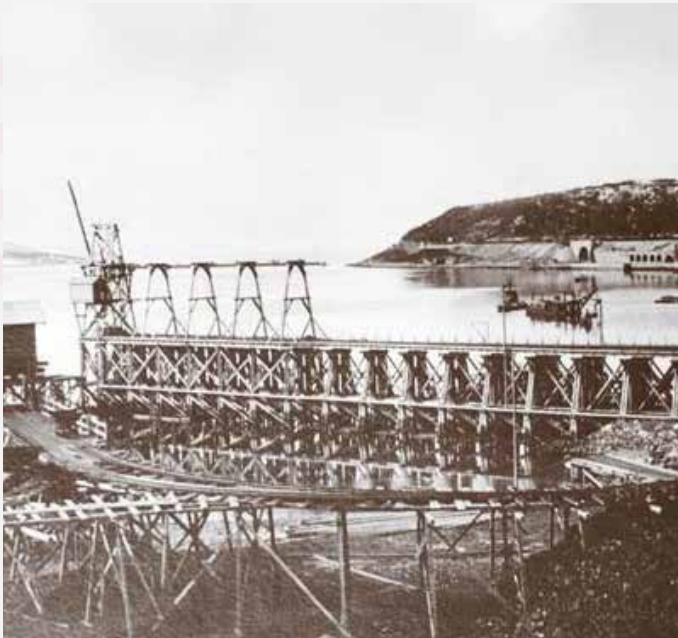




Europe 's northernmost core port

- the Port of Narvik is an international logistics hub with substantial potential for future growth

The Port of Narvik, a key player in northern logistics and maritime trade, stands as a central hub in the Arctic region. Located on the northern coast of Norway, at the entrance to the Ofotfjord, Narvik Harbour has a history that stretches back to the beginning of the 20th century. With its strategic location and modern infrastructure, the port has played a decisive role in the development of the region and in international trade. From being a central port for the export of iron ore to acting as a diverse hub for maritime transport, logistics and industrial activity, the Port of Narvik continues to be a center for economic growth and sustainable development. By offering efficient logistics solutions and maritime services, the Port of Narvik has seen a steady growth in traffic. As Europe's northernmost TEN-T core port, the Port of Narvik is actively seeking new development and growth opportunities. The world is constantly changing. 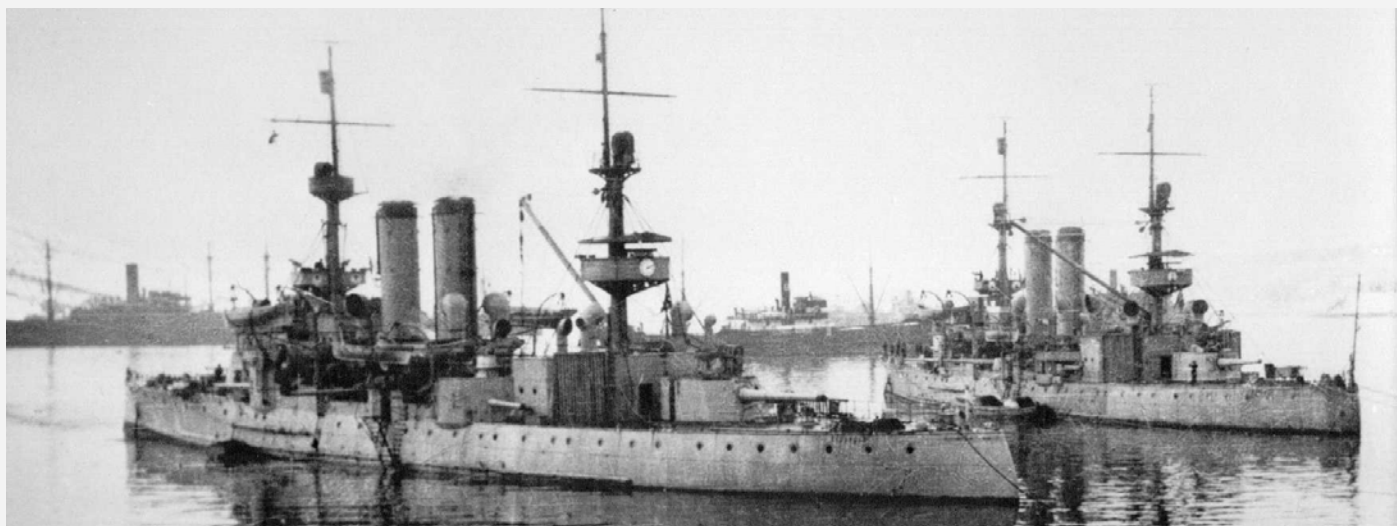
Echoes of the past

- milestones in the history of Narvik harbor

The Port's history is rich and varied, and it stretches back to the beginning of the 20th century. Here is a brief overview of some important events and milestones in our history:

1. **The founding of Narvik as a port city:** Narvik was established as a port city at the beginning of the 20th century when it was decided to build a railway from Kiruna in Sweden to Narvik to enable the export of iron ore from the rich mines in the Kiruna region.
2. **The construction of port infrastructure:** During the early years, extensive port infrastructure was built to handle the increasing amount of iron ore exported from Sweden via the port. This included wharf areas, storage facilities and rail links to the mines.
3. **World War II:** During World War II, Narvik played an important role as a strategic port for both German and Allied forces. The Battle of Narvik in 1940 was one of the first major sea battles.
4. **The post-war period and modernisation:** After the war, the port underwent a period of reconstruction and modernisation. Investments were made in infrastructure and expansion of port capacity to meet the needs of an increasingly globalised trading world.
5. **Diversification of the business:** In recent years, the Port of Narvik has diversified its business and expanded its role to include not only the export of iron ore, but also the import and export of other types of goods, as well as cruise and passenger traffic. The new cruise pier opened in October 2019.

Throughout its long history, the Port of Narvik has been a central player in the region's economic development and international trade, and it continues to play an important role today as a strategic logistics hub in Northern Norway.

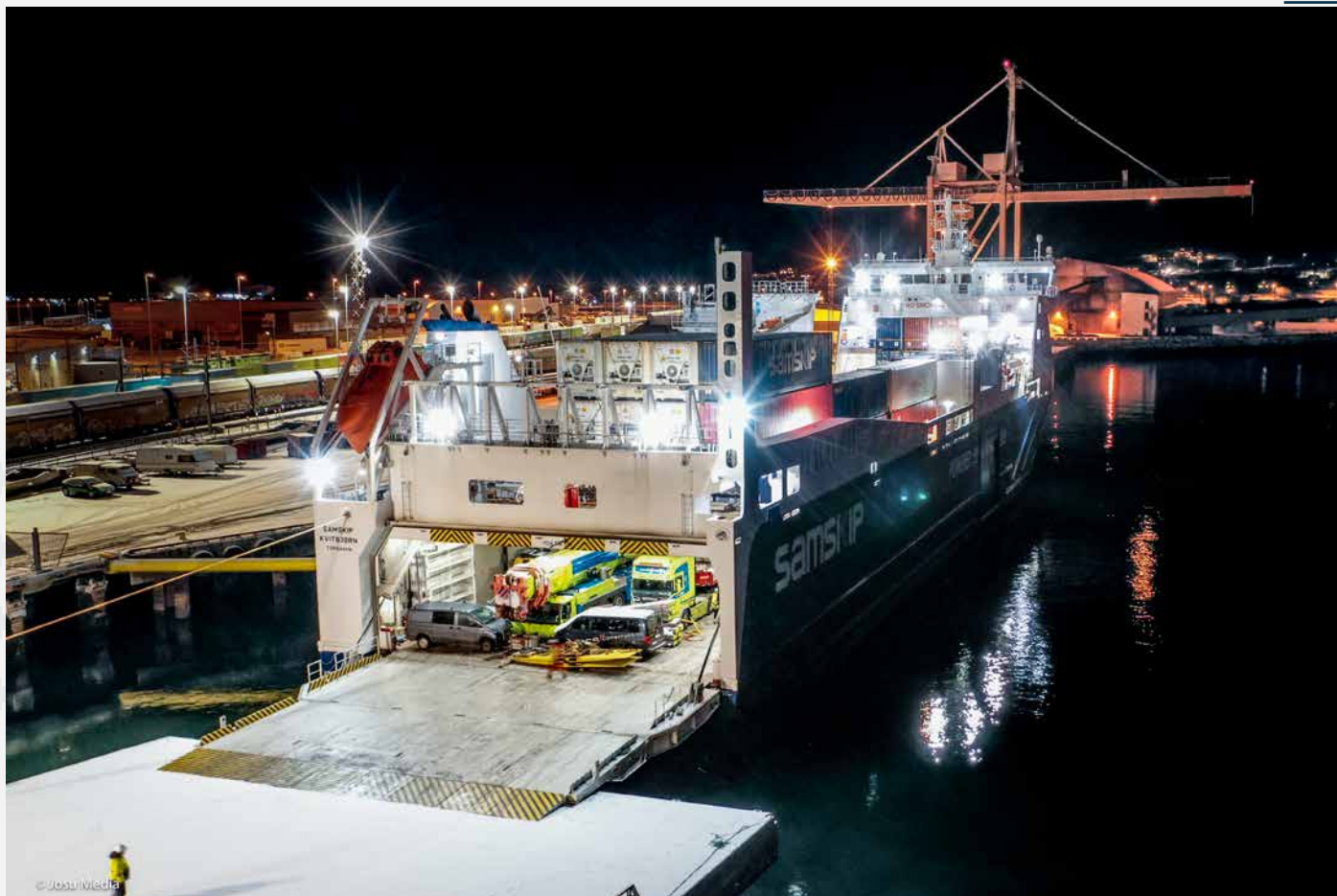

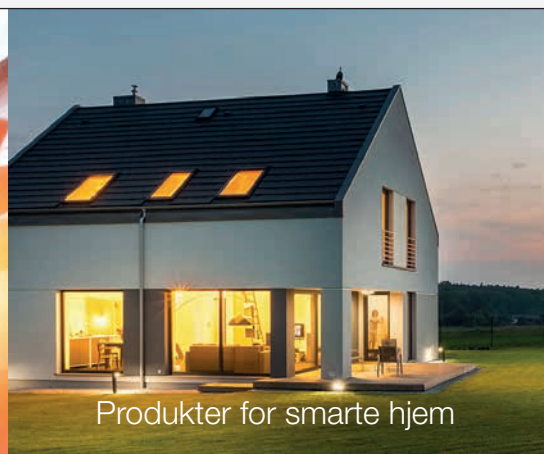

- Cruise to Narvik

The cruise industry has gradually increased its presence in Narvik in recent years, and the destination has become an increasingly attractive stopover for cruise ships exploring the northern waters. With its spectacular nature and unique cultural offerings, Narvik and its surrounding areas attract more and more tourists every year.

Cruise calls to Narvik give visitors the opportunity to experience the majestic landscape of northern Norway, with the dramatic fjords, snowcapped mountain peaks and the rich wildlife that characterises the region. Narvik's location near Lofoten and Vesterålen also makes it an excellent starting point for exploring these iconic archipelagos.

In addition to the scenery, Narvik is the home of Ofoten railway, the navvies, the famous bears Salt & Pepper, the unique war history, Sami history, midnight golf and friendly locals. Narvik was the first industrial town in Northern Norway and was given town status in 1902 when the construction of the Ofoten railway was completed. The town centre and unique culture was formed by and is still influenced by Swedish navvies, British engineers and sailors from across the world. In March each year, Norway's oldest festival – Vinterfestuka (Winter festival week) – takes place here. This week-long event pays homage to the navvies with everyone dressing up in period costumes.

The Port of Narvik has invested in infrastructure to meet the needs of a growing cruise industry and offers modern port facilities and services to ensure a smooth and comfortable experience for both passengers and crew.

- the strategic impact of Knutepunkt Narvik

Knutepunkt Narvik (The Narvik Hub) is an exciting initiative that aims to develop Narvik into a central logistics hub in northern Norway and northern Europe, and the Port of Narvik plays a decisive role in this project.

Through cooperation between public authorities, private companies and other stakeholders, Knutepunkt Narvik seeks to strengthen the region's position as a strategic hub for freight and passenger transport, as well as to promote business development and sustainable growth.

Rail: On-dock rail connecting the Port of Narvik with southern Norway, the Nordic countries, central Europe and Asia. The green choice - the entire rail network is electrified.

Sea: Ice-free port all year round. Deep water harbour. Environmentally friendly transport corridor east/west & north/south connecting sea and rail.

Road: European roads E6 and E10 allow for flexible and easy access to markets.

Air: Harstad/Narvik Evenes is an international airport 40 minutes from the port. Wide body airport with one of Norway's longest runways.

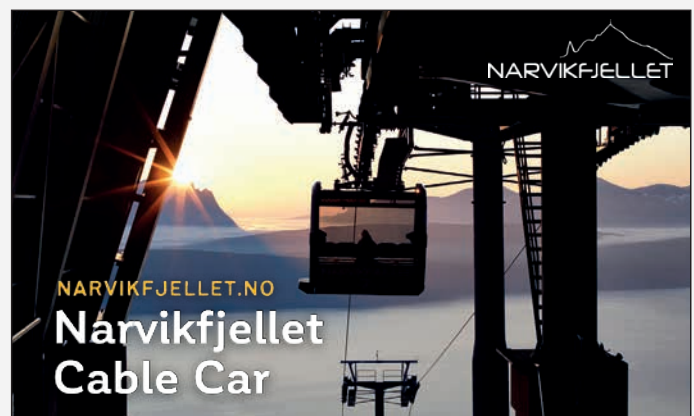

Narvik Harbor operates on VHF channel 14 (the main channel for Narvik Harbor), in addition to the emergency and calling channel VHF channel 16.
